Distribute food to homeless men with Worship Outside the Walls or Brotha to Brotha.

Prepare a meal for Sista 2 Sista, a ministry helping women out of prostitution and addiction in Binghampton.

Organize a youth event to for a collaborative learning experience between Christ Methodist youth and children from the Binghampton Art Garden.

For high school and college students: work a week at SOS repair roofs for families with a fixed income.

Participate in a missions training event hosted by World Methodist Evangelism or Follow One International.
